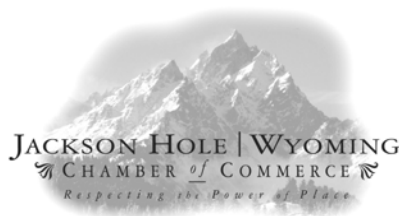

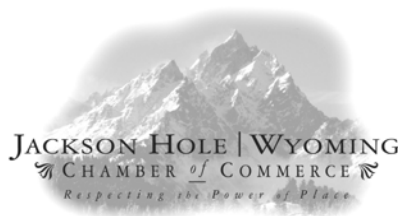

National Elk Refuge Sleigh Rides

The largest wintering herd of elk in North America can be found on the north edge of Jackson. For a close-up view, ride onto the Refuge in a horse-drawn sleigh. Dress warmly and bring your camera. Sleigh



rides depart from the Jackson Hole Greater Yellowstone Visitor Center located on 532 N. Cache. You can see elk exhibits and a slide show at the Visitor Center where you purchase tickets for rides and leave your car. The sleigh ride lasts about 45 minutes to an hour. Rides run every 20 to 30 minutes from 10am to 4pm daily, beginning in December 14th through March. Reservations accepted. Call for sleigh ride info, Visitor Center:

Nordic Skiing Centers & Guide Service

The following Nordic touring centers provide access to kilometers of well-groomed trails at nominal daily rates. Rentals, lessons and guides are also available. Backcountry guide service is also available for backcountry use. Whether it's through unmarked backcountry or over a maintained track at a touring center, cross-country skiing in Jackson Hole features scenery and wildlife unlike anywhere else in America. There are four touring centers, and all three downhill ski areas allow cross-country skiing on the slopes for regular lift rates (telemark skis recommended). You'll find marked trails in Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks and in the Bridger-Teton and Targhee National Forests. Please check in first with Park and Forest personnel.

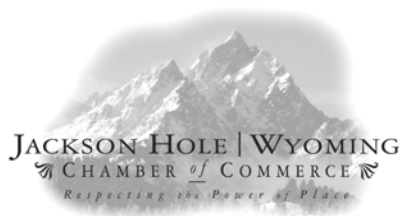

Yellowstone National Park

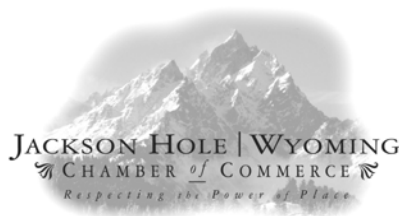
Yellowstone is a magical world in winter. Visitors can explore the abundant wildlife of the world's first National Park via snowcoach, snowmobile or cross-country skis. (Park roads are closed to automobile traffic early November to early-May.) Access to the south entrance of from Jackson is just 54 miles north of town, and transportation is available. Guided tours (skiing, snowcoach, snowmobile) are available. Overnight lodging is available at Mammoth Hot Springs Hotel and Old Faithful Snow Lodge. Reservations are recommended. Grand Teton National Park

Although well known as a summer and fall attraction, Grand Teton National Park is getting more and more attention from winter vacationers. Most winter activities start at the Craig Thomas Discovery and Visitors Center in Moose, Wyoming 12 miles north of Jackson. Activities include ranger-led snowshoe hikes (reservations required), cross-country skiing. Unguided snowmobiling on the the Continental Divide Trail through Grand Teton National Park links the Bridger-Teton National Forest with Flag Ranch



and the Grassy Lakes Road as well as ice fishing on Jackson Lake.

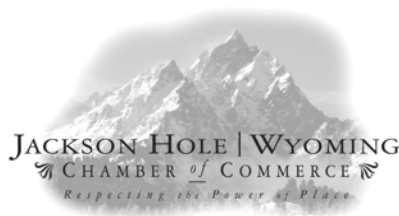
